- *Applicants who wish to reside in the International House, but do not know if you pass an examination or not must apply for it, without waiting for the examination results. Please note that applicants who have been denied enrollment are not entitled to move in.

4. Eligibility

- (1) New international students who will enroll in Kumamoto University from academic year 2019 (Fall Semester).
 - *Exclusive of elective course students (called kamokuto-rishusei in Japanese)
- (2) International students who have not lived in the International House before (exclude of elective course students). *Returning international students who had been residents of the International House before and had left Japan after that are eligible.

5. Period of Residence: 6 months or 1 year

- *Move-in date: September 18, 2019 for undergraduate exchange students, September 30, 2019 for other students
- *Regular students can stay at the International House for half year.

(Please note that there is a possibility for the period to shorten depending on the circumstances.)

- (1) The deposit will be refunded after taking out the cleaning fee, if any equipment and furniture have no damage.
- (2) The rent for the months the resident moves in and out are pro-rated on a daily basis.
- (3) Rental fee for Futon(Bedding) is also needed
- (4) Utility fee for Shared Room (quad) is subject to change.

7. Responsibilities

Residents are required to obey the regulations of the International House. If you feel it difficult to do so, you are advised to find accommodation other than International House. (We might order residents to move out from International House if they break the rules.) For more details, please read the booklet entitled "Kumamoto University International House Occupant Regulations" which is available at the Global Education Division.

- * Moving-in&out have to be taken during its office hours: Mon-Fri 9:00am. to 4:00pm (3:00pm for move-out) on weekdays. (Except for Saturday, Sunday, National holidays.)
- * Having guests stay overnight in the International House is strictly prohibited. Lending your room out to someone is also strictly prohibited.
- * You must not lend out or duplicate International House keys.
- * There may be occasions when personnel and/or other staff members need to enter rooms without notice in order to do emergency checks on room equipment and furnishings.
- * Please disposal of your garbage on the specified collection day at designated site.
- * All residents must take turns cleaning the garbage station.
- * Please park bicycles and motorcycles in designated parking places.
- * To keep the bed mattress clean, please rent futon(bedding).
- * I-House is non-smoking in all locations whether public spaces, shared areas or private rooms, even outside of the buildings. We order you to move out if you smoke.
- * Do not keep or feed pets or other animals in the I-House.

*Please note: There is a possibility that there are not enough rooms to accommodate everyone if we receive many applications. Also, we might not be able to meet your request for room types etc. The selection results will be announced around the end of August or beginning of September.
