This is to notify international students that the International House for academic year 2022 (Spring Semester) is now open for application.

### 1. Application

- Student Affairs Section, School of Medicine (4th Floor of Medical Educational & Library Bldg., Honjo Campus)
- International Student Office (2nd Floor of General Education Bldg., Kurokami North Campus)

\*Students who have already had academic advisors should submit the application form through them.

\*Students who will attend programs such as student exchange program should submit application form to contact person of the programs.

\*Applicants who wish to reside in the International House, but have not received the examination result yet, should apply for IH. Please note that the applications of those who failed the examination will be cancelled.

**The International House cannot be used as a place to stay for a 14-day quarantine when entering Japan.**

### 3. Rooms Available

Single Room	A, B, E	Kitchen, shower and toilet, air conditioner, bed, wardrobe, refrigerator, IH cooker, desk, chair, shoe shelf
Shared Room (only available for undergraduate exchange students)	C, D	Air conditioner, closet, bed, desk, chair *4 Private rooms with shared lounge, kitchen, shower and toilet, air conditioner, cupboard, refrigerator, washing machine, microwave oven, IH cooker, dining table, chair, shoe shelf

### 4. Eligibility

(1) New international students who will enroll in Kumamoto University from academic year 2022 (Spring Semester).

\*Exclusive of elective course students (called *kamokuto-rishusei* in Japanese)

(2) International students who wish to reside in the International House (exclude of elective course students). Those who have lived in the International House before are also eligible.

### 5. Period of Residence

Half-Year: From April 1, 2022 to September 9, 2022

1-Year : From April 1, 2022 to March 17, 2023

\*Regular students can stay at the International House for half a year.

\*Applicants, who wish to have a specific period of residence, are advised to consult with International Student Office individually.

## 6. Fees (JPY per month)

- (1) The deposit will be refunded after taking out the cleaning fee, if any equipment and furniture have no damage.
- (2) The rent for the months the resident moves in and out are prorated by the day.
- (3) Common Service Charge is fixed and **can't be prorated.**
- (4) Rental fee for Futon (Bedding) is also needed.
- (5) Utility fee is subject to change.

## 7. Responsibilities

Residents are required to obey the regulations of the International House. If you feel difficult to do so, you are advised to find accommodation other than International House. (We might order residents to move out of International House if they break the rules.)

- \* Moving-in & out have to be taken during the office hours: between 9:00am and 4:00pm (3:00pm for move-out) on weekdays. (Except for Saturdays, Sundays, National holidays.)
- \* Letting guests stay overnight in your room is strictly prohibited.
- \* The opposite gender is forbidden to enter the shared room except for renter's family members.
- \* You must not lend out or duplicate International House keys.
- \* There may be occasions when staff need to enter rooms without notice in order to do emergency checks on room equipment and furnishings.
- \* Please dispose of your garbage on the specified collection day at designated site.
- \* Please park bicycles and motorcycles in designated parking places.
- \* To keep the bed mattress clean, please rent futon (bedding).
- \* **I-House is a smoke-free premises including public spaces, shared areas or private rooms, even outside of the buildings. We order you to move out if you smoke.**
- \* Do not keep or feed pets or other animals in the I-House.

**\*Please note:** There is a possibility that there are not enough rooms to accommodate everyone in case of if many applications. Also, we might not be able to meet your request for room types etc. The selection results will be announced around the end of February or beginning of March.
